Arrival:

by train:

to Küblis station (between Landquart and Davos), from there with "Postbus" to St. Antönien center (St. Antönien Platz) <u>https://www.postauto.ch/-/media/postauto/fahrplan-und-netz/liniennetz/dokumente/graubuenden/praettigau.pdf?vs=1</u> from there it is 1 km on foot, but it is also possible to get a lift from the guesthouse.

by car:

highway A13/E43 (St. Margarethen – Chur) until Landquart, further direction "Davos" until Küblis, at the beginning of Küblis turn left to St. Antönierstraße (direction Luzein / St. Antönien), until St. Antönien center, in the center turn to the right direction "Gasthaus Bellawiese/guesthouse Türli". There is a little Parking place.

Our accommodation is the cosy guesthouse "Türli" <u>https://haus-tuerli.eu/</u> in St. Antönien/Ascharina directly at the bottom of the mountain "Eggberg".

I have reserved 5 nights (25.02. until 02.03.2022). If you want, you can stay longer, provided beds are free – please hurry to make your reservation in that case.
